HSSV saves every healthy and treatable animal that comes through our doors. Our goal is to make it possible for all California shelters to do the same.

Spay and Neuter

Through **onsite surgeries**, **community mobile clinics**, and **targeted S/N**, HSSV is reducing the number of animals entering shelters.

Regional Rescue

HSSV transfers **vulnerable animals** from partner shelters to free up space and resources.

Adoptions and Specialized Care

HSSV nurtures **every animal's well-being** and connects them with loving families.

HSSV hosts accessible mobile clinics offering **wellness care**, **spay/neuter**, and **vaccinations** in community locations. Our **Essential Care Community Clinic** in San Jose offers sick, injured, and non-emergency vet care for pets in need.

Pet Pantry

HSSV gives **food and pet supplies** to families who need it, so pets can stay with the loving family they already have.
